Based on equality and mutual benefit, after friendly consultations, Department of Tourism, Fudan University of China (FDDT) and Department of Business Administration / Division of Hospitality and Tourism Management, Athens University of Applied Sciences (TEI of Athens) have reached the following understandings on educational, internship and research cooperative activities to promote further cooperation between FDDT and TEI of Athens, through their representatives, Prof. Pericles Lytras, Vice-Rector of the TEI of Athens and Director of the MSc in Tourism Entrepreneurship and Prof. Hung Yang, Dean of the Department of FDDT, as follows:

Article 1 Contents of MOU

1. Cooperation in education programs, such as Master in Tourism Administration (MTA) Program.
2. Students exchange, including the exchange among undergraduates, post graduates and PhDs.
3. Teaching staff exchange. Encourage to strengthen cooperation of both parties through mutual visits of teachers and other forms.
4. Research cooperation. Develop scientific research cooperation in the field of mutual interests and establish the platform of research cooperation for exchanging academic journals and books.
5. Other programs regarded as appropriate for exchange by both parties.

Article 2: Scope and Definitionsof MOU

1. This MOU serves as a framework agreement, while any activity related to the collaborative areas included in the MOU should be regulated by specific agreements affiliated to this MOU.
2. In order to promote the cooperation, both parties agreed to work for the affiliated agreements as early as possible.

Article 3 Implementation of MOU

1. In order to implement this MOU effectively, both parties will authorize related departments of the School to take responsibility for the implementation of the MOU.
2. TEI of Athens and FDDT will be responsible for (1) the drafting and signature of the agreements affiliated to the MOU for specific cooperative programs based on full consultation between each other; (2) the implementation of all signed agreements

affiliated to the MOU; (3) supervising and involving in the whole process of the related collaborative activities.

Article 4 Text of MOU

This agreement is prepared in English text in two original copies. Each university keeps one copy and both copies have equal legal effect. .

Article 5 Alteration of MOU

If necessary, the two parties can make modifications and supplementations to the present MOU through mutual consultations. Issues not specified in this MOU shall be solved through friendly consultations between the two parties.

Article 6 Effectiveness of MOU


This MOU will be valid for five years as of the date of signature by the representatives of both parties and can be terminated by informing the other side in written notice six months prior to the date of expiration. After the term expiry, under the same condition, both parties have the precedence right to extend this MOU.
